Blend A blend of 80% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Cabernet Franc

Colour Deep red with vibrant hues.

Bouquet Fruit notes of black currants and raspberries that are balanced by tobacco leaf characters and quality

French oak.

Palate The entry into the palate is rich and generous with berry characters. These are framed by tobacco

leaf characters and cedary French oak. The tannins are mid weighted and well-integrated, giving

balance and savoriness. The finish is rounded and long.

A good example of a cool climate cabernet blend from what was a consistent vintage in Western

Australia. Enjoy with pasta and red meats over the next six to eight years.

winemaking The Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc are fermented separately and blended just before

bottling. Prior to bottling the wine is fined with a pea based (vegan friendly) fining agent.
