Harvest Date	Cabernet Franc 11 March 2020 and Cabernet Sauvignon 18 March 2020
Bottling Date	9th August 2021

Titration Acidity	6.5 g/L
Colour	Deep red with vibrant hues.
Bouquet	Fruit notes of black currants and raspberries that are balanced by tobacco leaf characters and quality French oak.
Palate	<p>The entry into the palate is rich and generous with berry characters. These are framed by tobacco leaf characters and cedary French oak. The tannins are mid weighted and well-integrated, giving balance and savoriness. The finish is rounded and long.</p> <p>A good example of a cool climate cabernet blend from what was a consistent vintage in Western Australia. Enjoy with pasta and red meats over the next six to eight years.</p>
winemaking	The Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc are fermented separately and blended just before bottling. Prior to bottling the wine is fined with a pea based (vegan friendly) fining agent.
